Machine end of life management

What is it about?

Wessex is committed to supporting our customers in the furthering of sustainable cleaning practices and promoting a circular economy.

We provide our customers with one less issue to resolve and provide full documentation to demonstrate compliance, ensuring correct treatment in line with most businesses CSR policies are followed. By recycling your old machines, a waste transfer document will be produced along with a recycling report that will give a raw material breakdown

You will also receive a residue statement of any material that cannot be fully recycled and is used for items such as road ballast and building blocks.



What happens?



Why do it?

Wessex is committed to sustainable cleaning, and helping customers achieve a zero waste to landfill solution. Recycling your machinery is a big step forward. Where does it go? The materials collected are certified and documented to ensure green-cycling of product components take place, meaning they are recycled into a new equipment or reused if recycling cannot be achieved.





How is it done?

It's simple, old machinery is collected from us and sent to a recycling centre where it is stripped and recycled to make a number of new components.

What's next?

The components are documented, and distributed to factories that can make use of them. We will then give you recycling report and a residue statement, so you can see where everything goes.





The Process



Let us know what machines that you would like recycling and ship them to us.



Wessex will arrange the collection, transportation, recycling and reporting.



When the machines have been evaluated and disassembled, you will receive a recycling report of what has been recycled.



For what can't be recycled, and a residue report will be given, showing you where these elements go (often used in road ballast and building materials)



Wessex will send you all reports to demonstrate the circular recycling solution.
